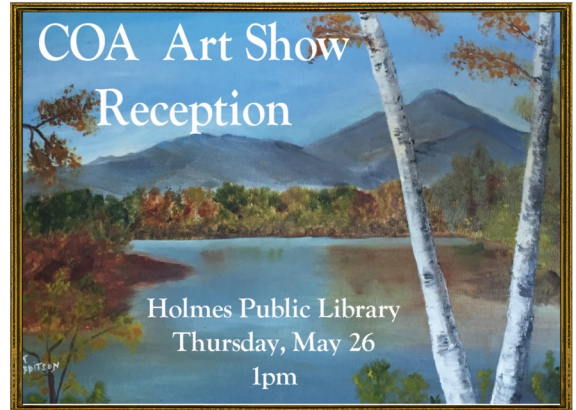
Combined with the accompaniment of orchestral arrangements, his "Words, Wind, and Wood" weaves words and music to create a unique experience.



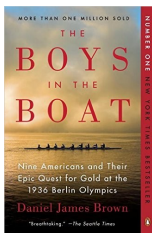

And join the celebration on Thursday, May 26 at 1pm as we share thanks and refreshments in honor of these artists.

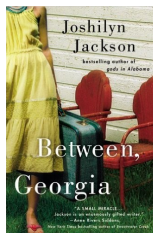
