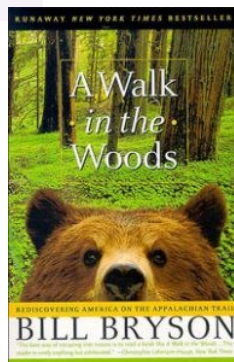

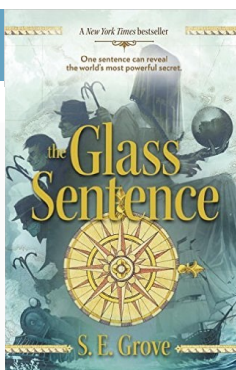
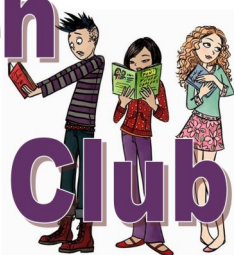
A Community Read brought to you in the Spring of 2017. The Holmes Library will have multiple copies of A Walk in the Woods by Bill Bryson available for checkout.

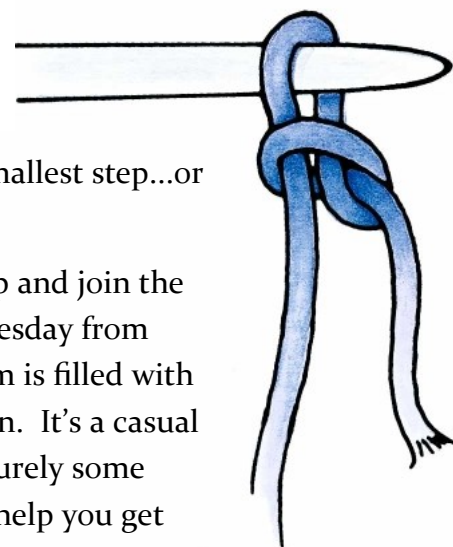
